

# Accommodations

You will stay on-campus at the UTown residential colleges in 6-bedroom apartments with your peers. Each room comes furnished with furniture, air-conditioning and internet access, and the apartment has a common living area with a dining table and sofas. In addition, each residential college has shared facilities within the building such as kitchenettes, laundry rooms and student lounges to create a living environment that encourages social, educational and cultural interaction. The residential colleges are also located within close proximity to classrooms, sports facilities and dining amenities within UTown.

Students can **check in by 19 June** and must **check out by 26 July 2014**. There will be a Welcome and Registration Session on 20 June 2014.

Cost of the accommodation is based on the check-in and check out dates indicated above.

\* For NUS students who wish to stay on-campus for FASStrack Asia, the same accommodation costs above will apply. However, NUS students who volunteer as student assistants for FASStrack Asia will be entitled to substantial housing subsidies for the summer.
