Along with the Ewha-Samsung international House(dormitory for exchange students) adjacent to it, Ewha Graduate Student Dormitory makes the little "global village of Ewha." Numerous kinds of foreign language can be heard in this area from English, French, Chinese to Japanese and many more Asian, African, Europian languages.

The dormitory, established in September 2006 to enhance the globalization of Ewha, consists of two 9-story buildings which sum up to 16,597 m² gross area.
