

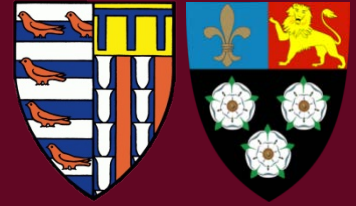

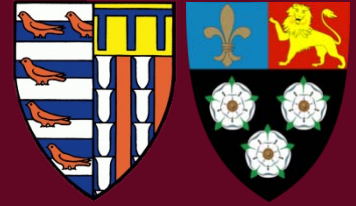
Cambridge

- A beautiful city filled with museums, art galleries, theatres and libraries



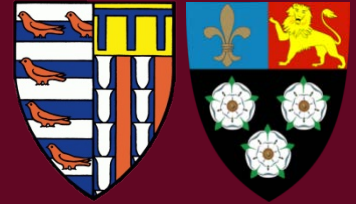
The PKP Experience

Academic Programme

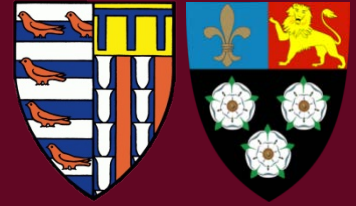


Unique Features

- Cambridge style of teaching:
 - Intensive small group teaching
 - Out of classroom interaction
 - Individual feedback on performance
 - Guided independent study
- Class sizes capped at 30 students; seminars usually at 15 students allowing for interactive engagement with young enterprising viewpoints from around the world
- Independent Supervision option: exceptional opportunity to experience Cambridge-style supervisions



Academic Programme

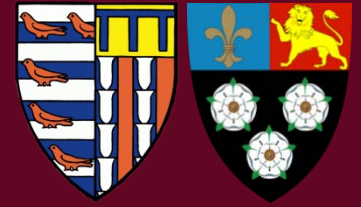


Courses

- Around 45 courses available in: Social Sciences, Science and Maths, Economics, Business and Management, Arts and Humanities
- 12 Lectures, 8 Seminars per course (25 contact hours)
- Students choose three courses (4 credits each); or two courses and one supervision
- Assessment: usually take-home exam and final dissertation
- Formalised feedback during the course allowing students the opportunity to learn and improve academic performance



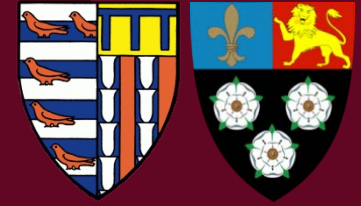
Academic Programme



Independent Supervision (Optional)

- Replaces one course
- Extraordinary opportunity to work on an independent research project of the student's own choosing under guidance of a Supervisor (expert in the field)



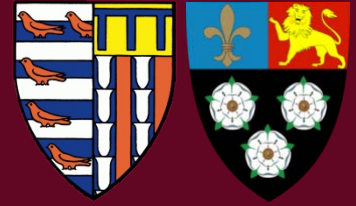


Accommodation and Meals

- All students have single occupancy rooms in College accommodation
- Meal plan at Pembroke or King's
 - ✓ Various dietary requirements are catered for
 - ✓ Pembroke College is allergen and coeliac UK accredited
- Three Formal Halls
 - ✓ Three-course meals served in historic dining halls



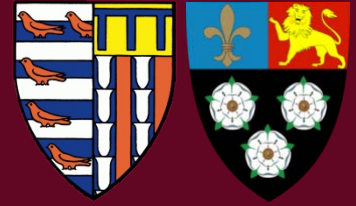
Social Programme



- A team of Cambridge Students act as Programme Assistants (PAs) to organise social activities
- Social programme:
 - ✓ Free / Subsidised activities organised throughout the programme. Such as:
 - Football / Cricket
 - Karaoke nights
 - A walk to Wimpole Hall or Grantchester Tea Rooms
 - Punting on the river Cam
 - And more!



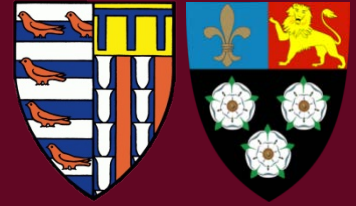
Programme Costs



- Application Fee: £60
- Tuition Fee: £3,850
 - ✓ Courses fee
 - ✓ Study skills sessions (Social Sciences and Sciences)
 - ✓ Three plenary lectures
- Accommodation Fee:
 - ✓ Between £1,746 - £2,372 depending on accommodation band
 - ✓ Includes meal plan and social programme
- Independent Supervision Supplement: £990 (optional)



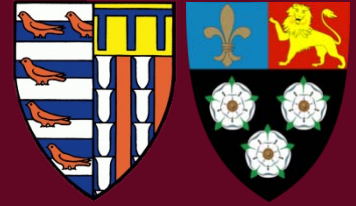
Applications



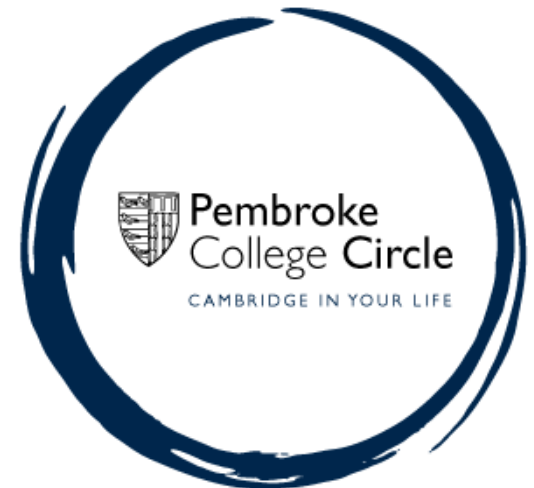
- Online application: **open now!**
- **Places fill up fast – early application recommended**
- Minimum GPA of 3.2
- Supporting documents: transcript and academic reference sent directly by home institution or academic referee
- Decisions on complete applications conveyed in 15 working days



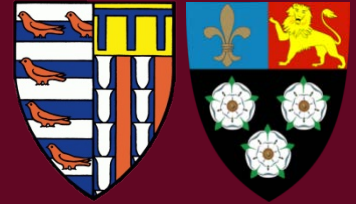
Pembroke College Circle
