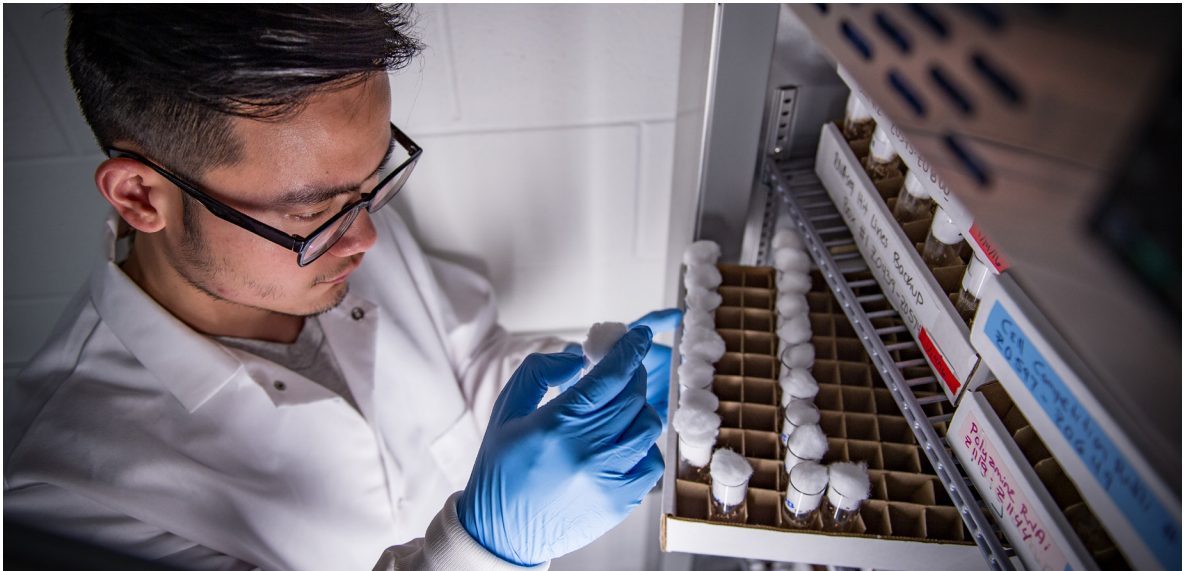


iSURE

International Summer Undergraduate Research Experience

The iSURE program provides opportunities for international undergraduate and Master's students to participate in engineering and science research at the University of Notre Dame. Students will gain valuable, hands-on research experience and exposure to broader areas of science and engineering research. Students work closely with Notre Dame faculty and graduate students on a variety of ongoing research projects.



The iSURE program is open to all international students who are enrolled as undergraduate or Master's students in a university overseas. Notre Dame also works closely with the following partner universities in China, Mexico, and India:

- Fudan University (China)
- Peking University (China)
- Sichuan University (China)
- Tsinghua University (China)
- Zhejiang University (China)
- Instituto Tecnológico y de Estudios Superiores de Monterrey (Mexico)



The University of Notre Dame, located in South Bend, Indiana (90 miles from Chicago), is consistently ranked among the top 20 universities in the United States.

Program Dates

India & Mexico: Saturday, June 4 – Saturday, July 29, 2017 (8 weeks)

China: Sunday, July 2 – Saturday, August 12, 2017 (6 weeks)

If you are not from one of the partner universities listed above and are applying independently, you may choose to come during either of the above time frames.

Cost

\$4,000

COST INCLUDES:

- Tuition
- Lab fees
- Housing on campus for the entire program
- Meals: \$20 per day meal allowance
- Ground transportation to and from Chicago O'Hare International Airport (ORD)
- Medical insurance
- Day trip to Chicago
- Opening and closing reception with participating faculty
- Other program-sponsored activities

COSTS DO NOT INCLUDE: round trip airfare to O'Hare International Airport, passport and visa fees, personal spending money
